## 1. Seats available for admission process to be carried out under these rules :

20% seats of the sanctioned intake are available as over and above the sanctioned intake in all the Polytechnics / institutes in state for direct admission to the Second Year of Post SSC full Time Diploma Courses.

Sr.No	Qualification required	Seat Available	% of Marks Required
1	12th Science with Technical/Vocational	20% of the SI of course (includes 2 seats of ITI and MCVC each)	50% marks in aggregate or in PCM group for General (45% for reserved candidates)
2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>ITI (2 years duration)</li><li>center of excellence course of 2 yrs duration</li></ul>	2 seats out of 20% of the SI	60%
3	MCVC	2 seats out of 20% of the SI	60%

## 2. Eligibility Criteria

The required educational qualification for the additional seats is either H.S.C (Technical / vocational) of Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education is as follows.

The candidate should be Indian national with minimum 50% marks in aggregate or in PCM group at HSC science with Technical/Vocational (45% marks in aggregate or PCM at HSC in case of Backward Class category candidates recognized as backward class category in Maharashtra State only)

**OR**

I.T.I / center of excellence course with minimum 60% marks

**OR**

H.S.C (M.C.V.C) with minimum 60% marks.

### Note:-

Eligibility of the student for the specific branches of diploma programmes shall be as per MSBTE guidelines.

- Any vacant seats available in second year / third semester of post S.S.C diploma programme may be filled by the students acquiring either H.S.C (Technical / vocational) of Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education at the end of admission process.

Candidate seeking admission against these seats shall apply directly to Principal of the concerned Institute. Separate admission round strictly as per inter-se- merit shall be conducted for admission for these seats and all seats as GENERAL seats.

### **3. Assignment of merit number**

Merit of all eligible Maharashtra State candidates will be based on the Aggregate marks obtained at HSC (Std. XII) or equivalent qualifying examination only course wise.

Relative merit in case of a tie (i.e. equal marks in Aggregate marks obtained at HSC (Std. XII) or equivalent qualifying examination) shall be resolved as given below.

### **4. Relative Merit in case of tie:**

In case of tie, i.e. candidates having equal aggregate marks in qualifying examination, the inter-se merit of candidates shall be reassessed as laid down below:

#### **For HSC Vocational/Technical Candidates**

- A candidate who has secured higher % of marks in the subject of Mathematics at H.S.C. examination will have First priority.  
A candidate who has secured higher % of marks in the subject of Physics at the H.S.C. Examination will have Second priority.
- A candidate who has secured higher % of marks in the subject of chemistry at the H.S.C. Examination will have Third priority.

#### **For ITI/MCVC Candidates**

- A candidate who has secured higher % of marks in the subject of Mathematics at S.S.C. examination will have First priority.
- A candidate who has secured higher % of marks in the subject of Science at the S.S.C. Examination will have Second priority.
- A candidate who has secured higher % of marks in the subject of English at the S.S.C. Examination will have Third priority.
